

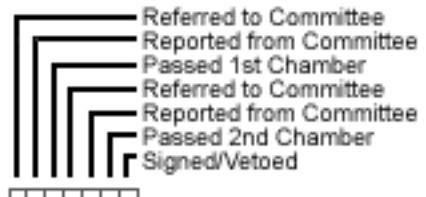

HB 1049 (1) **Allen** Defines "cyberbullying" as it relates to the antibullying policy that school districts must adopt and establishes specific requirements for each school district in implementing the policy.

HB 1082 (1) **Wells** Specifies that licensed professional counseling includes the diagnosis of mental, emotional, and behavior disorders.

HB 1193 **Frederick** Establishes the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Act to monitor the prescribing and dispensing of controlled substance.

HB 1306 **Berry** Prohibits caffeinated malt beverages from being imported, produced, manufactured, distributed, or sold at any retail outlet in this state.

SB 587 (1) **Chappelle-Nadal** Allows school districts and charter schools to establish and implement an age-appropriate curriculum to educate students about domestic violence.
